1. Call to order

    - i. Justin Roberson states that during a staff meeting staff talked of ways that students can complete work without the use of Internet.
  - g. Brienne McDowell asks if there is a textbook, or something of the sort, that is accessible to parents to give them more help when teaching remote.
  - h. Scott McClung states that his goal, not speaking for the whole board, his goal is to keep students in-person teaching as much as possible.
