If funding is approved, this will give more chances for students to use our programs such as Amplify, Reading Seeds, IXL, Khan Academy, Google Classroom and much more.

A couple of reminders to help us all reach our greatest success:

- **Weather Related Schedules:** Maine Consolidated believes it is important for families to have the information surrounding alternative schedules.

\*Decisions are based on a number of factors, safety of our staff travel, student travel, weather forecasts, and impact on learning. We will use **one-call** to let families know the alternative schedule for the day, here are the three options:

- **Delayed Start:** school begins two hours later
- **Remote learning:** students and staff should be prepared for remote learning, activities online or paper pencil, that can be submitted upon the child's return the next day, so learning can continue as scheduled.
- **School is canceled:** we do have four snow days built into the schedule that we can utilize without having to change our end date.
