Arizona State Tax Credit

You Get Your Money Back!

Donations to public school have always been tax deductible. A tax deduction allows you to subtract the amount of a contribution from the amount of your taxable income. The law allows a *tax credit*, which is subtracted from the amount of taxes you owe.

You Need Not Be a Parent!

The tax credit is available to all Arizona taxpayers whether or not they have children in the public schools.

It's This Easy!

To support any of the programs listed on the Response Card, write a check to the school or schools of your choice. Send your check to the school or the district office with the Response Card.

You may indicate on the memo line what program or class you want to support.

You will be provided a receipt verifying that you contributed to an eligible activity. When you file your taxes simply claim your tax credit of up to \$400 on your state income tax return (tax credit form 322) and list the district's CTDS #03-03-10-101.

Do It Today!

Schools are planning activities now. Your contribution can make a big difference in a young person's life. If you are considering making a contribution, send your check today or call the school for further information.

A Tax Credit is a Full Refund of Your Money!

You Have Many Choices

To claim the tax credit, taxpayers must contribute to an activity or an academic program for which the school district requires a fee. You may contribute to one of the three general categories listed below or you may specify a program on the list you want to support.

- General
- I-40 Sports
- Field Trips
- Fine Arts

A contribution gets the money where it needs to go... To the kids!!

Contributions that are eligible for a tax credit and donated directly to schools, not to state and not even to the school district. The funds are not subject to the revenue control limit that prevents schools from spending more than a fixed amount for programs. Increased funding will allow more children to participate in activities.

Arizona State Tax Credit – Getting your tax dollars where you want them!

Arizona allows state income taxpayers to receive a tax credit of up to \$400 for a married couple, \$200 for a single person, for contributions made to public schools to support extracurricular activities.

You Help Kids!

Extracurricular activities such as sports, music and fine arts or field trips generally cannot be fully funded by school district revenues and depend on fees from students. Arizona tax law allows taxpayers a tax credit of up to \$400 if they contribute to activities in public schools supported by fees.
