If your student would like to walk in the parade or ride on the school bus, please read the following information carefully and fill out and submit the online permission form. You must have the permission slip filled out and submitted in order to attend the parade.

When: Friday, July 4th

Timeline:

11:45 AM — **Meet at Maine Consolidated Gym**. Please note the school is under construction. Please do not walk the campus or go on the playground. Students Check in with Dr. J to turn in permission forms and find out your role in the parade.

12:00PM – Parade Line up begins. Students will be transported on the bus or parents may be asked to bring any additional students that will be walking to the parade line up area.

1:00 PM – Parade Begins (Parade is proximity 30 minutes long).

1:45 PM – Students return to families at Maine Consolidated Gym.

Transportation: Student MUST have an adult drop them off and pick them up.

Recommended Attire: Wear your best red, white and blue! Please check the weather before arriving and dress accordingly. Wear walking shoes and please bring a water bottle.

Parade Theme: Route 66 Main Street of America.

Participation: This is an optional but fun event for Maine School Students. We encourage families to watch their student in the parade but the only people in the parade will be the students, Maine School Staff, and our volunteers.

Parade Details: Students participating in the parade will be walking, rising the bus, waving, handing out candy, holding our banner, or holding flags.

Student Conduct: Students will be expected to follow the same rules and expectations they have at school, as well as follow the directions of the parade volunteers and any other Maine School staff.
